Eligibility Criteria

- ❑ The awards are open to any person living within the WKPMA list of Parishes (list available from the Secretary)
- ❑ The Applicant must be a member of the WKPMA and must remain a member for at least five years
- ❑ The area of study/research must be relevant to the Cereal or Hop Industry within the EU

Regulations

- ❑ The award offers a monetary award which must be used for the purpose you apply for eg tuition fees, research fees and or costs etc).
- ❑ The successful applicant will receive 50% of the funding prior to the beginning of the award, and then the remaining 50% on completion of a 15 minute presentation at the next November Prize-Giving evening.
